UK/EU Fees and funding grants for 2008 – 2009

Bath Spa University Fees 2008-2009

Normal University Fees (UK/EU residents)

£3,970 – full-time fee (UK/EU students only)

Whole-school Consultancy Fees

These will be kept to a minimum and in many cases all fees will be waived towards the costs of university accreditation and providing a CPD Affiliated Field Consultant/Tutor (AFC/T) attached to the school or school cluster.

Qualified Teachers in schools (QTS) have the following funding opportunities:
